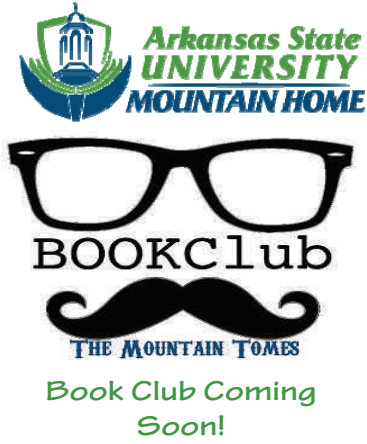

Stop by the library any time and meet our wonderful Staff.

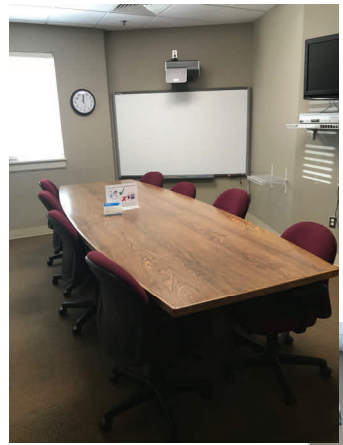
