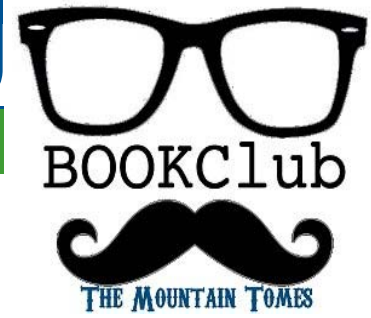




What's Up in the Library.....

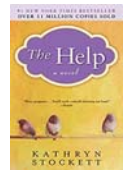

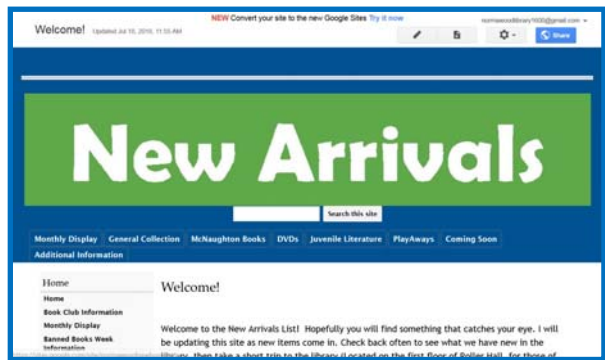
Read and watch them both and then you decide what you think. It could be fun and relaxing!
